NOTICE OF 7-DAY PUBLIC REVIEW FOURTH AMENDMENT OF THE FY 2008-2013 CONSOLIDATED PLAN AND THE FY 2008-2009 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City has prepared the Fourth Amendment of the Fiscal Years 2008-2013 Consolidated Plan, and the Fiscal Year 2008-2009 Annual Action Plan (The Plans).

On February 17, 2009, the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA) was signed into law. Included in the ARRA was an allocation of \$735,792 to the City of Oxnard, under the Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG-R) for FY 2008-2009.

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), the Administrator of the CDBG-R funds, requires at least a 7-day public review period and a submission of a substantial amendment and other required documents for the FY 2008-2009 Annual Action Plan. The publication of this notice begins the public review period which will start on Monday, October 19, 2009 and conclude at 5:00 p.m. on Monday, October 26, 2009.

At this meeting, the City Council will receive public comments on the use of the \$735,792 in CDBG-R funds. The intent of the CDBG-R is to stimulate the economy through measures that modernize the Nation's infrastructure, improve energy efficiency, and expand educational opportunities and access to health care. Jurisdictions are expected to use the CDBG-R funds for hard development costs associated with infrastructure activities that provide basic services to residents or activities that promote energy efficiency and conservation through rehabilitation or retrofitting of existing buildings.

The City proposes to use the funds to replace water pipe lines in the Bartolo Square North Neighborhood (\$662,213) and for administration of the CDBG-R Program (\$73,579). Once the amendment of The Plans has been adopted by City Council, it will be submitted for approval by HUD.
